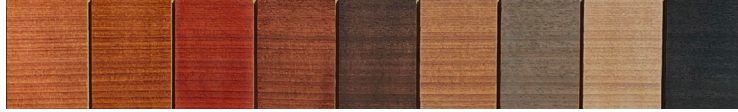




ExoShield Application on Ambara®



EXOSHIELD APPLICATION ON AMBARA®



- Ambara and other low-density thermally modified woods will absorb stain more readily than traditional softwoods. ExoShield will cover ~300 SF on Ambara.
- ALWAYS start by testing a small inconspicuous area to observe how ExoShield interacts with Ambara.
- ExoShield can be brushed, rolled or sprayed. Apply liberally. If brushing, start by brushing against the grain and then brush with the grain. Brushing against the grain initially will allow the pigments to fill the open pores in the wood.
- Wipe off excess thoroughly with a lint-free rag or towel within 10-30 minutes.
- Be sure not to let the finish sit too long prior to wiping or tack will begin to develop.
- DO not apply ExoShield when the wood is wet or relatively hot. The wood should be cool to the touch, or the finish will cure too quickly.
- SHAKE THOROUGHLY. ExoShield Antique Bronze and Platinum contain heavy pigments that will easily settle on the bottom of the can. If needed, stir gently with a clean stir stick.
- An additional coat MAY be added for a deeper color but only after the initial coat is fully cured. If a second coat is applied, it should be a VERY light coat.
- Ambara can be left to silver naturally. Reapplication is necessary if you choose to maintain the original or stained color. Frequency of reapplication will depend on multiple factors including but not limited to geographic area, ExoShield color, and level of UV exposure.
