Angelique is an outstanding and diverse tropical hardwood known for its unique properties. Angelique is also known as Basralocus and Naval Wood. While its stunning colors and grain make it well suited for a variety of aesthetic projects, its high durability, strength, and stability make it also suited for heavy industrial strength projects. Adding to this the species' unique traits regarding Marine projects and you have an excellent versatile species that can be applied in almost any project.

UNIQUE MARINE DURABILITY

The name Naval Wood refers to Angelique's unique capability of outstanding durability in marine applications. Nova's reclaimed timber product line, consisting predominantly of Angelique beams that are pulled from projects in Europe that are being remodeled or decommissioned. Often these beams have been in the water for thirty years or longer and due to the high durability and its unique trait of Marine borer resistance these angelique beams can easily be repurposed and given a second life in a whole new location.

Color: Angelique heartwood is reddish-brown-gray or yellowish-brown sharply demarcated from narrow brownish-white sapwood.

Family: Fabaceae-Caesalpinieceae

Tree Characteristics: The Angelique tree can grow to a height of 150 ft and diameters to 5 ft but more commonly to 3 ft. Boles are clear for 60 to 80 ft over heavy buttresses.


Geographic Area: Angelique is abundant in eastern Surinam and western French Guiana where it may make up 10% of the forest stands. Best growth on deep, loamy, well drained soils of lowland plains but also found in wet areas.

Texture: Medium

Grain: Straight

Luster: Unusual sub-surface luster

Durability Rating: Heartwood is resistant to very resistant to attack by decay fungi but is somewhat susceptible to dry-wood termites. The wood is resistant to attack by marine borers.

RECLAIMED HARDWOOD TIMBERS

Additionally, Nova carries a line of reclaimed Angelique beams from Marine projects in Europe. Typical beams range in size from 10×10 to 25×25 and from 35-39 feet in length. These beams are structurally sound on the inside and can be used "as is" in grey weathered form, or resawn into slabs or specialty sizes for timber framing and other structural and esthetic uses
