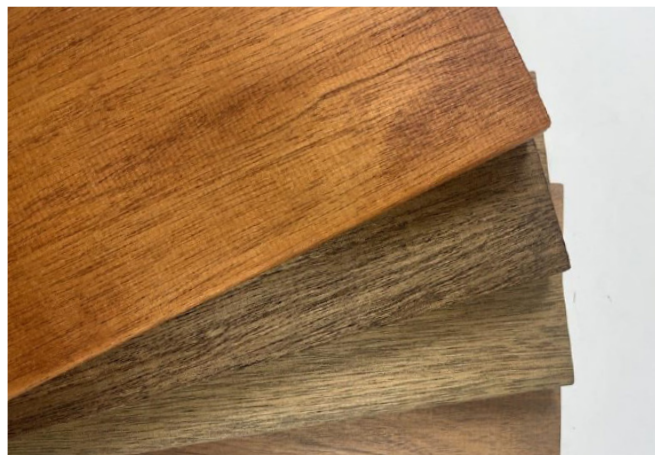


WHY FIJIAN MAHOGANY?

PERFECT INSIDE AND OUT

Nova's Fijian Mahogany is treated with Micronized Copper Azole (MCA), which enhances its longevity and makes it safe for both indoor and outdoor use. MCA treatment provides added protection against fungal decay and termites without compromising the wood's natural beauty or introducing harmful chemicals into living spaces. This treatment is particularly important for applications where wood is exposed to moisture or direct contact with the ground, ensuring that Fijian Mahogany remains a reliable and safe material for decking, siding, and even interior paneling. The combination of durability, sustainability, and safety makes Fijian Mahogany a superior choice for a wide range of building projects, from exterior decks to elegant interior finishes.

Wood: Heartwood reddish, pinkish, salmon colored, or yellowish when fresh; deepening with age to deep rich red or brown; distinct from the yellowish or whitish sapwood.

Geographic Area: Plantation grown in Fiji. Naturally distributed from Southern Mexico to South America.

Grain/Texture: straight to roey, wavy, or curly grain, often with an attractive figure. Texture rather fine to coarse.

Durability: Heartwood rates as durable in resistance to fungi. Moderately resistant to dry-wood termites. MCA treatment provides added protection.

Working Characteristics: Easy to work.

Finishing: Easily takes stains and paints.
